

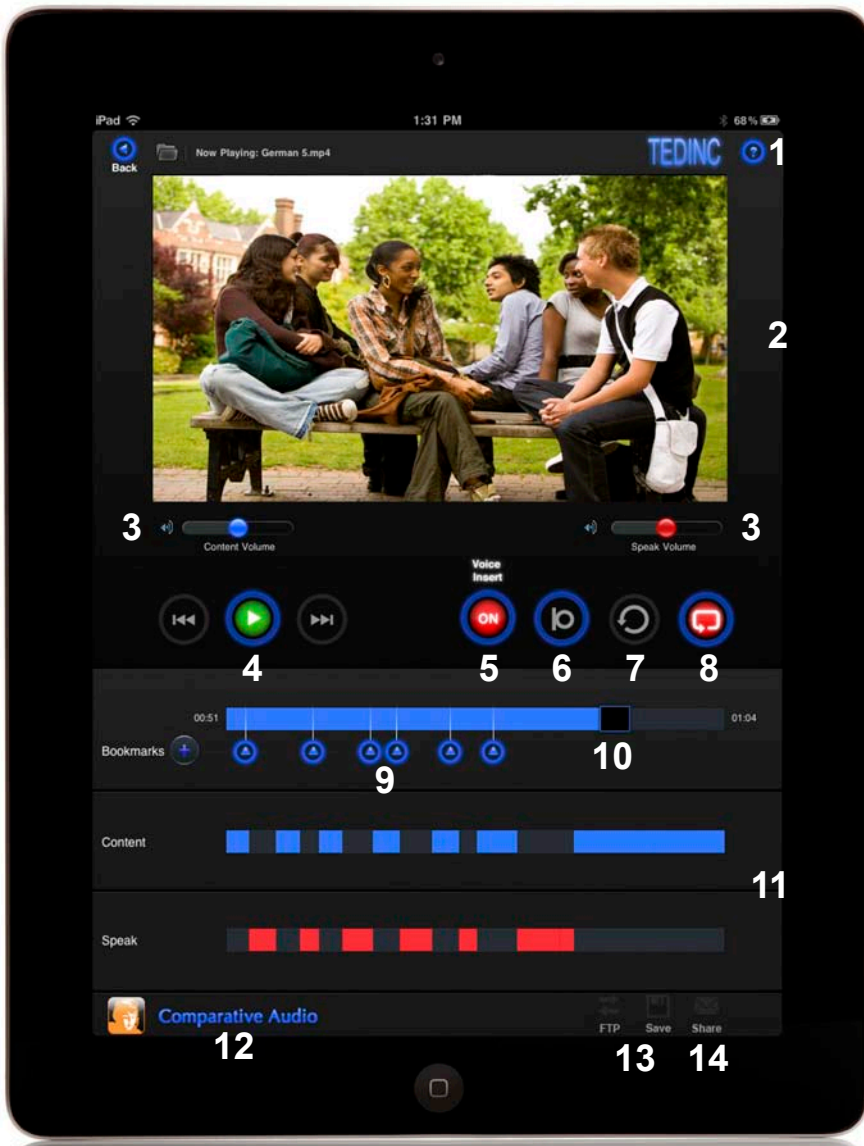
Comparative Audio

Comparative Audio® allows you to play audio and video files and you can record your voice simultaneously for audio comparison. You can use this unique tool to practice a new language to improve your pronunciation and intonation. With **Comparative Audio®** you can up-load and down-load files from a FTP server.



The Comparative Audio® App is a foreign language study recorder allowing simultaneous playback of content, audio or video, and recording of voice via the microphone.

1. Link to Quick Reference Guide.
2. Video viewing window.
3. Separate volume controls for Content and Speak.
4. Rewind, Play/Pause and Fast Forward controls.
5. Voice Insert to make gaps in the content to record your voice.
6. Speak to record your voice.
7. Recap will take you back to the beginning of the last Content segment when Voice Insert is used.
8. Repeat will play the file continually.
9. Bookmarks will quickly take you to your selected sections for repeated playback.
10. Move the Slider to any location in the file.
11. Visual display to show where you have recorded your voice.
12. Link to Comparative Audio web site.
13. FTP the file to your teacher or save your audio recordings for later review.
14. Share, to email your file.
